As of April 30, 2020, the total sum of \$2,163,078.05 has been disbursed in Base Amount and Matching Payments, between the twenty one (21) candidates certified under the Fair Elections Program; and the Committee to Elect Janeese Lewis George has received the maximum allowable cap for matching payments of **two hundred forty-one thousand and fifty-five dollars** (\$241,055.00) for qualified small dollar contributions for participating candidates for the covered office of Member of the Council elected from a ward during the 2020 Election Cycle, and the total base payment of \$40,000.00.
