**Community Outreach**

- On May 14, 2024, OCF participated in MPD’s Beat the Streets/DPR Late Night Hype orientation session. The event outlined the upcoming summer outreach initiative and sites that will take place at Recreation Centers in each of the city’s 8 Wards.
- On May 21, 2024, OCF held an Outreach event at the Anacostia Library Branch to provide residents with information on its Traditional and Fair Elections Campaign Finance programs.
- On May 21, 2024, OCF presented at ANC’s (SMD 5E02) meeting where information on the Agency’s Traditional and Fair Elections Campaign Finance programs was provided.

**2024 Election Cycle Debates**

The Office of Campaign Finance hosted the Debate on May 2, 2024, in the contested race for the Office of At-Large Member of the Council, which was scheduled for election during the June 4, 2024, Primary Election in the District Columbia. All Candidates certified to participate in the Fair Elections Program (FEP) in contested city-wide elections are required under the Fair Elections Act (the “Act”) to participate in the debates, and Candidates registered in the Traditional Campaign Finance Program (Traditional Program) who qualify for ballot access in these elections are invited to participate.

For the June 4, 2024, Primary Election, based on those Candidates who achieved Ballot Access, there were a total of two (2) certified Participating Candidates in the Fair Elections Program seeking the Office of At-Large Member of the Council who participated in the Debate. There were no Candidates in the Traditional Campaign Finance Program who qualified for ballot access in the Democratic Primary Election.

The Debate was moderated by Sam Ford, the former Bureau Chief for ABC 7News (WJLA). The Debates were held virtually and streamed live online at the [dcdebates.com](https://dcdebates.com) Website. The recordings

of the OCF sponsored debates will remain online for viewing throughout the remainder of the calendar year at [dcdebates.com](https://dcdebates.com).

### **2024 Primary Election Site Review**

The Office of Campaign Finance conducted onsite visits to 21 of the Early Vote Centers from May 25, 2024 through June 2, 2024, and to 46 of the Vote Centers on June 4, 2024, Primary Election Day, to provide guidance where necessary concerning the application of the Campaign Finance Laws. Many Centers showcased large numbers of campaign literature, but all appeared to be appropriately placed outside of the electioneering markers. The OCF Teams randomly selected campaign literature to ensure that the appropriate identification disclaimers were present and satisfactory. Finally, the OCF Teams did not observe and were not alerted to any conflict-of-interest activities or to any complaints involving campaign-related activities.

## **FAIR ELECTIONS PROGRAM DIVISION**

The following is an accounting of the FEP's production stats for the Month of May 2024:

### **AUTHORIZED FOR BASE AMOUNT AND MATCHING PAYMENTS**

**2020 Election Cycle.** By way of background, the 2020 Election Cycle was the first election cycle during which the Fair Elections Program was fully implemented. The total sum of **\$4,016,797.64** was disbursed from the FAIR ELECTIONS FUND in BASE AMOUNT (\$1,120,000.00) AND MATCHING PAYMENTS (\$2,896,797.64) to the Thirty-Six (36) Candidates certified in the Fair Elections Program to participate in the June 2, 2020, Primary Election, the June 16, 2020, Special Election (also conducted during this timeframe), and the November 3, 2020, General Election. The 2020 Election Cycle closed on November 3, 2020, and the 2020 Special Election Cycle closed on June 16, 2020.

**2022 Election Cycle.** The Office of Campaign Finance authorized for the total sum of **\$12,358,606.95** for disbursement from the FAIR ELECTIONS FUND in BASE AMOUNT (\$1,680,000.00) AND MATCHING PAYMENTS (\$10,678,606.95), to the Forty-Two (42) Candidates certified in the Fair Elections Program to participate in the June 21, 2022, Primary Election (Thirty-One (31) Candidates) and the November 8, 2022 General Election (Eleven (11) Candidates). The 2022 Election Cycle closed on November 8, 2022.

**2024 Election Cycle.** As of this date, there are Fifteen (15) certified Participating Candidates in the Fair Elections Program, and the Office of Campaign Finance has authorized the disbursement of the total sum of \$2,353,743.10 from the Fair Elections Fund in Base Amount and Matching Payments.

## **ONGOING 2020 POST-ELECTION FULL FIELD AUDITS**

The 2020 Election Cycle. The following Ten (10) Post-Election Audits are currently ongoing before the Fair Elections Program at various stages, including Audit Documentation received and Audit in progress; Audit Complete and the Preliminary Statement of Findings issued, and/or Response received and Under Review/Draft Final Audit submitted to the Audit Manager and Under Review; and Failure to submit Audit Documentation and Referred to the Office of the General Counsel (OGC). The FEP Division has issued a total of Twenty-Four (24) Final Audit Reports of the Thirty-Four (34) Post-Election Audits initiated for the 2020 Election Cycle.

**Post-Election Audits – The June 2, 2020, Primary Election** (Audits initiated on June 19, 2020, of the Campaign Operations of those Candidates who did not proceed to the General Election):

1. Green for Ward 7 – Audit documentation received on August 6, 2020. Draft Final Statement of Audit Findings submitted to FEP Manager for review.
2. Mike for Ward 8 – Audit complete. **Preliminary Statement of Finding issued on June 23, 2021.** Response submitted on July 14, 2021. Draft Final Statement of Audit Findings submitted to the FEP Manager for review.
3. Kishan for DC 2020 – Referred to the Office of the General Counsel (OGC) on February 16, 2021, for failure to submit the required documentation. Hearing held on March 10, 2021, no response from Committee, 2<sup>nd</sup> Hearing held on March 25, 2021 no response from Committee. The OGC issued an Order on April 20, 2021, and the Committee was fined One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Referred to the OGC for further action on May 23, 2022.
