#### OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR

The 2022 Post-Election Cycle Report was published on the OCF Website on September 1, 2023, as required by D.C. Official Code Section 1- 1163.32j (a). The Data presented in this Report is based on information reported in the Reports of Receipts and Expenditures filed with the Office of Campaign Finance covering the start of the campaigns of the Candidates referenced therein through December 31, 2022. The coverage period of the Report incorporates the December 10th, 2022 Report of Receipts and Expenditures, the last financial report filed which included receipts eligible for matching payments and collected after the closing date of the coverage period for the October 2022, 8 Day Pre-General Election Report, and immediately before or on the November 8, 2022 General Election.

The Report is presented in four parts. Part I is an Overview of the 2022 Election Cycle and the Fair Elections Program; Part II is the OCF review of the national trends in public funding programs in other jurisdictions; Part III, is the presentation of statistical data of the 2022 Election Cycle; and Part IV contains significant data pertaining to the 2022 Election Cycle and the Lists of QSDCs (Qualified Small Dollar Contributors) and Expenditures for all Fair Elections Program Candidates.

#### **Community Outreach**

Information regarding the Agency's Traditional Campaign Finance and Fair Elections Programs was disseminated at twelve (12) Beat The Streets (BTS) Community Outreach Events. #### FAIR ELECTIONS PROGRAM DIVISION

The following is an accounting of the FEP's production stats for the Months of July and August 2023:

#### AUTHORIZED BASE AMOUNT AND MATCHING PAYMENTS

**2020 Election Cycle.** By way of background, the 2020 Election Cycle was the first election cycle during which the Fair Elections Program was fully implemented. The total sum of \$4,016,797.64 was disbursed from the FAIR ELECTIONS FUND in BASE AMOUNT (\$1,120,000.00) AND MATCHING PAYMENTS (\$2,896,797.64) to the Thirty-Six (36) Candidates certified in the Fair Elections Program to participate in the June 2, 2020, Primary Election, the June 16, 2020, Special Election (also conducted during this timeframe), and the November 3, 2020, General Election. The 2020 Election Cycle closed on November 3, 2020, and the 2020 Special Election Cycle closed on June 16, 2020.

**2022 Election Cycle.** The Office of Campaign Finance authorized the total sum of \$12,358,606.95 for disbursement from the FAIR ELECTIONS FUND in BASE AMOUNT (\$1,680,000.00) AND MATCHING PAYMENTS (\$10,678,606.95), to the Forty-Two (42) Candidates certified in the Fair Elections Program to participate in the June 21, 2022, Primary Election (Thirty-One (31) Candidates) and the November 8, 2022 General Election (Eleven (11) Candidates). The 2022 Election Cycle closed on November 8, 2022.

**2024 Election Cycle**. As of this date, there are two (2) certified Participating Candidates in the Fair Elections Program. There were no Candidates certified to participate in the Fair Elections Program or disbursements authorized during the Month of July 2023.
