Community Outreach

December 2025, the Office of Campaign Finance (OCF) participated in the following community outreach events sharing valuable insights about its Campaign Finance Programs with participants.

December 3, 2025 - The Office of Campaign Finance made virtual training available to the public covering the full range of the Audit Process for the Traditional and Fair Elections Campaign Finance Programs.

December 10, 2025 - The Office of Campaign Finance made virtual training available to the public titled Understanding the Rules of the Game introducing Candidates and Treasurers to the rules and regulations governing the Traditional and Fair Elections Campaign Finance Programs.

FAIR ELECTIONS PROGRAM DIVISION

The following is an accounting of the FEP's production stats for the Month of December 2025:

AUTHORIZED FOR BASE AMOUNT AND MATCHING PAYMENTS

2020 Election Cycle. By way of background, the 2020 Election Cycle was the first election cycle during which the Fair Elections Program was fully implemented. The total sum of **\$4,016,797.64** was disbursed from the FAIR ELECTIONS FUND in BASE AMOUNT (\$1,120,000.00) AND MATCHING PAYMENTS (\$2,896,797.64) to the Thirty-Six (36) Candidates certified in the Fair Elections Program to participate in the June 2, 2020, Primary Election, the June 16, 2020, Special

Election (also conducted during this timeframe), and the November 3, 2020, 2020, General Election. The 2020 Election Cycle closed on November 3, 2020, and the 2020 Special Election Cycle closed on June 16, 2020.

2022 Election Cycle. The Office of Campaign Finance authorized for the total sum of **\$12,358,606.95** for disbursement from the FAIR ELECTIONS FUND in BASE AMOUNT (\$1,680,000.00) AND MATCHING PAYMENTS (\$10,678,606.95), to the Forty-Two (42) Candidates certified in the Fair Elections Program to participate in the June 21, 2022, Primary Election (Thirty-One (31) Candidates) and the November 8, 2022, General Election (Eleven (11) Candidates). The 2022 Election Cycle closed on November 8, 2022.

2024 Election Cycle. There were Nineteen (19) certified Participating Candidates in the Fair Elections Program, and the Office of Campaign Finance authorized the disbursement of the total sum of \$2,834,646.15 from the Fair Elections Fund in Base Amount (\$570,000.00) and Matching Payments (\$2,254,646.15). The 2024 Election Cycle closed on November 5, 2024.

2025 Special Election Cycle. There were Three (3) certified Participating Candidates in the Fair Elections Program, and the Office of Campaign Finance authorized the disbursement of the total sum of \$447,472.90 from the Fair Elections Fund in Base Amount (\$120,000.00) and Matching Payments (\$327,742.90). The 2025 Special Election Cycle closed on July 15, 2025, the date of the Special Election.

2026 Election Cycle As of this date, there are Eleven (11) certified Participating Candidates in the Fair Elections Program, and the Office of Campaign Finance has authorized the disbursement of the total sum of \$2,019,659.70 from the Fair Elections Fund in Base Amount and Matching Payments.

2. Brian for DC 2026 for Council Ward 3 Principal Campaign Committee. Matching payment in the amount of One Hundred Seventy-One Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$171,280.00) was authorized for disbursement on December 16, 2025.

3. Frumin 2026 for Council Ward 3 Principal Campaign Committee. Matching payment in the amount of Twenty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$26,975.00) was authorized for disbursement on December 16, 2025.
4. Frumin 2026 for Council Ward 3 Principal Campaign Committee. First Half Base amount payment in the amount of Twenty-Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) was authorized for disbursement on December 31, 2025.
5. Goodweather for DC Principal Campaign Committee. Gary Robert Goodweather was certified on December 16, 2025, as a Participating Candidate in the Fair Elections Program for the Office of Mayor of the District of Columbia in the June 16, 2026, Primary Election. The First Half Base amount payment in the amount of Twenty-Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) and Matching payment in the amount of Two Hundred Fifteen Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars and Eighty-Five Cents (\$215,265.85) was authorized for disbursement on December 16, 2025.
6. Gloria for Ward 6 Principal Campaign Committee. Gloria Ann Nauden was certified on December 17, 2025, as a Participating Candidate in the Fair Elections Program for the Office of Ward 6 Member of the Council in the June 16, 2026, Primary Election. The First Half Base amount payment in the amount of Twenty-Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) and Matching payment in the amount of Thirty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars and Seventy-Five Cents (\$36,523.75) were authorized for disbursement on December 17, 2025.
7. Candace for DC 2026 Principal Campaign Committee. Candace Tiana Nelson was certified on December 17, 2025, as a Participating Candidate in the Fair Elections Program for the Office of At-Large Member of the Council in the June 16, 2026, Primary Election. The First Half Base amount payment in the amount of Twenty-Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) and Matching payment in the amount of Seventy-Nine Thousand One Hundred Forty-Five Dollars and Sixty-Five Cents (\$79,145.65) were authorized for disbursement on December 18, 2025.
8. Re-Elect Charles Allen Ward 6 2026 Principal Campaign Committee. Charles Allen was certified on December 18, 2025, as a Participating Candidate in the Fair Elections Program for the Office of Ward 6 Member of the Council in the June 16, 2026, Primary Election. The First Half Base amount payment in the amount of Twenty-Thousand Dollars

(\$20,000.00) and Matching payment of One Hundred Six Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars (\$106,635.00) were authorized for disbursement on December 18, 2025.

9. Team Oye Principal Campaign Committee. Matching payment of Fifty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$52,684.20) was authorized for disbursement on December 19, 2025.

10. Terry Lynch for DC Principal Campaign Committee. Matching payment of One Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$1,425.00) was authorized for disbursement on December 16, 2025.

11. Jackie the Warrior for Ward 1 Principal Campaign Committee. Jakeline Maryori Reyes Yanes was certified on December 22, 2025, as a Participating Candidate in the Fair Elections Program for the Office of Ward 1 Member of the Council in the June 16, 2026, Primary Election. The First Half Base amount payment in the amount of Twenty-Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) and Matching payment in the amount of Fifty Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$50,770.00) were authorized for disbursement on December 22, 2025.

12. Aparna for DC for Council Ward 1 Principal Campaign Committee. Matching payment of Forty-Three Thousand Two Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$43,220.00) was authorized for disbursement on December 23, 2025.

ONGOING 2020 POST-ELECTION FULL FIELD AUDITS

The 2020 Election Cycle. The following Post-Election Audits are currently ongoing before the Fair Elections Program at various stages, including Audit Documentation received and Audit in progress; Audit Complete and the Preliminary Statement of Findings issued, and/or Response received and Under Review/Draft Final Audit submitted to the Audit Manager and Under Review; and Failure to submit Audit Documentation and Referred to the Office of the General Counsel (OGC). The FEP Division has issued a total of Thirty (30) Final Audit Reports of the Thirty-Four (34) Post-Election Audits initiated for the 2020 Election Cycle.

Post-Election Audits – The June 2, 2020, Primary Election (Audits initiated on June 19, 2020, of the Campaign Operations of those Candidates who did not proceed to the General Election):

1. Green for Ward 7 – Audit documentation received on August 6, 2020. Draft Final Statement of Audit Findings submitted to FEP Manager for review.

Post-Election Audits: The November 3, 2020, General Election (Audits initiated on March 30, 2021, of the Campaign Operations of those Candidates who participated in the November 3, 2020, General Election).

1. Committee to Elect Jeanne' Lewis for City Council – Audit documentation received on August 15, 2021. Audit in progress.
2. Monica Palacio for City Council - Audit initiated on March 30, 2021. No documentation has been received as of June 30, 2021. Referred to OGC on August 23, 2021. Audit documentation received on Oct. 5, 2021. Audit in progress.
3. Will Merrifield for DC - Audit documents received on June 6, 2021. Audit in progress.

ONGOING 2022 POST-ELECTION FULL FIELD AUDITS

The Office of Campaign Finance issued Forty-Two (42) Post-Election Audits Letters for June 21, 2022, Primary Election and the November 8, 2022, General Election to Candidates who were certified to participate in the 2022 Election Cycle. (Audits initiated on March 13, 2023, and March 24, 2023). To date, the FEP has issued Twenty-Four (24) Final Audit Reports for the 2022 Election Cycle.

ONGOING 2024 POST-ELECTION FULL FIELD AUDITS

The Office of Campaign Finance issued Nineteen (19) Post-Election Audits Letters for the June 4, 2024, Primary Election and November 5, 2024, General Election to Candidates who

were certified to participate in the 2024 Election Cycle. (Audits initiated on February 3, 2024). To date, the FEP has issued Nineteen (19) Preliminary Audit Reports and Nineteen (19) Final Reports for the 2024 Election Cycle, including the following:

Post Election Audits - 2025 Election

Trayon White 2025 – The Preliminary Draft Audit Report (PAR) was issued on November 3, 2025. The Committee has not responded to the PAR or to reminder emails as requested by the Audit Staff. Hearing referral in progress.

FEP Program - Post 2024 Election Audits

- Committee to Elect Eboni-Rose Thompson – The Preliminary Draft Audit Report was issued on April 18, 2025. Conference call was held 6/26/25 to discuss Findings and recommendations of the PAR. Committee requested further conference call on 8/5/25. The call was held with a due date of 8/11/25. Referral to OCF General Counsel on August 13, 2025. Hearing scheduled for September 11, 2025 rescheduled and held on September 17,

2025. The Committee corrected all outstanding issues on November 28, 2025. The final audit report is being drafted.

Traditional Program – Post 2024 Election Audits

- Re-Elect Trayon White 2024 – The Preliminary Draft Audit Report was issued on April 18, 2025. The response was received on May 20, 2025. Email sent on May 28, 2025, listing outstanding issues per PAR. Extension granted until 7/7/25 to completely respond to the Par. The Committee was referred to the OCF General Counsel on 6/9/25. Hearing scheduled for 8/20/25. The hearing was held. The Committee requested a Motion to stay the administrative proceedings. The OCF granted the Motion for stay on September 11, 2025. The final audit report has been drafted.

- Jacque for DC 2024 – Pre-Audit fieldwork completed. The records were not received. Hearing scheduled on March 26, 2025, rescheduled to May 2, 2025 and held on 5/29/25. The records were not received. The OCF General Counsel issued order with fines 8/1/25.

- T. Michelle Colson SBOE Ward 4 – The Preliminary Draft Audit Report was issued on June 11, 2025. The response was due on 8/11/25. Extension requested and granted until September 2, 2025. The Committee was referred to the OCF General Counsel on September 3, 2025. The hearing was held on September 25, 2025. The Committee requested assistance in filing the amended reports per audit. The Committee met with the audit manager on October 8, 2025, for assistance with the filings. Additional documents were received on November 10, 2025. The documents were reviewed and found to be insufficient. The Audit staff is in the process of drafting the final audit report.
