

This notice is to advise that pursuant to D.C. Official Code Section 1-1163.12a, A Political Action Committee (PAC) shall not make an independent expenditure unless it establishes a non-contribution account for the purpose of making such independent expenditures. The non-contribution account must remain segregated from any other accounts that are used by the PAC to make direct contributions to candidates, political committees, other PACs; or political parties. No contribution to the PAC shall be deposited in the non- contribution account unless the contributor has specifically designated the contribution for the purpose of making an independent expenditure.

The PAC is required to notify the Office of Campaign Finance within ten (10) days after establishing a non-contribution account.

This requirement is effective immediately. Any independent expenditure reported on the PAC's next required Report of Receipts & Expenditures must be supported by contributions made to the non-contribution account.
